

Privacy Policy Dragongaz Sp. z o.o.

Service does not collect any information except cookies files.

Cookie files (so-called "cookies") are computer data, mainly text files, that is stored in end-devices of the Website User and is intended for use with the pages of the Web Service. Typically, cookies contain the name of a website from which they come, their storage time on end-devices and a unique number. The Website Operator places cookies in Website Users' end-devices and has direct access to them is dragongaz.pl. Cookies are used for the following purposes:

- adjusting the content of the Website to the user's preferences and optimizing the use of the website; In particular, these files allow you to recognize the User's Device and display a web page tailored to your individual needs;
- creating statistics that help to understand how Website use web pages, which may lead to improvement of the structure and its content

The Website uses mainly two basic types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files that are stored in the end-device of the User until logging-out, leaving the website or turning off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored in the end-device of the User for a specified time that is determined in cookie parameters or until the User deletes them. The following cookies are used in the Service:

"necessary" cookies, which allow you to use the services available within the Service, such as authenticating cookies used for services requiring authentication under the Service

"security" cookies, such as those used to detect fraud in the authentication of the Service;

"performance" cookies to collect information about how to use the Website;

"functional" cookies, which allow you to "memorize" user settings and personalization of your user interface, such as the language or region you are referring to, the font size, the appearance of your website "advertising" cookies, which allow users to provide content that is more tailored to their interests. In many cases, web browser software (web browser) by default allows cookies to be stored on the end user's device. Website Users can change these settings. The web browser allows deleting cookies. It is also possible to block cookies automatically. Details of how to do so can be found in the help section or the browser documentation. Restrictions on the use of cookies may influence some of the functions available on the Website pages. Service may change cookies settings at any time. These settings may be changed in particular to block automatic cookie handling in the web browser settings or to inform them of each time they are posted on the User's Web site. For detailed information on how cookies are handled and, see the software settings (web browser) The Service Provider informs that restriction on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionality available on the Website. Cookies posted on the End User's Site may also be used by advertisers and partners who cooperate with the Service.
